Master of Management Studies : 2 years full time (MMS) - Intake - 60 seats

Admission Procedure:

The students desirous to get admission to MMS must appear for the CET (Common Entrance Test), GD & PI conducted by the Directorate of Technical Education, Govt. of Maharashtra or the institute level exam conducted by the Association of Management of MBA / MMS Institutes (AMMI). Students who have appeared for MAT, XAT, ATMA, CAT can also apply to DTE for GD & PI.

Eligibility Criteria:

Basic Qualification: In order to secure admission to first year of two-year full time MMS course, the candidate should fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

Passed with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (45% in case of candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State only) in any Full Time Bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration in any discipline recognised by the Association of Indian Universities

OR

Appeared for the final year examination of any Full Time Bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration in any discipline recognised by the Association of Indian Universities. Such candidates can be considered for provisional admission subject to passing the Degree exam with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (45% in case of candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State only)

NOTE:

Candidate is advised to ensure before applying for the CET and the admission to the MMS in a particular University that he/she is eligible for admission to the programme as per the relevant Eligibility Rules of that University.

The Trust is Hindi Linguistic minority. Hence candidates with Hindi mother tongue are eligible to apply for minority seats.

Eligibility Criteria for admission against Minority Seats / Institute Level

- 1. Candidate should be an Indian National and should posses basic qualification as specified.
- 2. In case of minority seats, the candidate should belong to the minority community/group for which the institute has secured minority status.
- 3. Appeared for GMAT (conducted by GMAC, USA only for NRI candidates) / CAT (conducted by IIMs) / JMET (conducted by IITs) / MAT (conducted by AIMA in February 2010) / ATMA (conducted by AIMS) / XAT (conducted by XLRI). OR Appeared for CET conducted by the agency (including Association of all colleges of a particular type in the State approved by Pravesh Niyantran Samiti, Bandra (E) for seeking admission to MBA/MMS for the academic year 2010-11.

Such candidates are required to appear for the GD & PI conducted by the Management of the respective institutes. **OR** Appeared for the Common Entrance Test (MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2010), GD & PI conducted by the Competent Authority of Maharashtra State for the academic year 2010-11.

Other eligibility criteria as per MBA / MMS CET 2010 Information Brochure of Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State.

Note:

- To become eligible for admission the candidate should score 30 or more marks in MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2010 OR
 equivalent score of 30 marks or more in the All India CET(CAT/JMET/ATMA/XAT/MAT (conducted in February 2010)/in
 GMAT OR equivalent score of 30 marks or more in the CET conducted by the agency (including Association of all colleges of
 a particular type in the State).
- Candidates seeking admission against the Minority Seats in Minority Institutes will have to fulfill any additional eligibility
 criterions as specified in the Government Resolution and its amendments which may be published from time to time.
